# School Sport Update

- There have been 4 inter house sports event this year - The 'Chippie Chase' Cross Country Run, Football Tournament, Sports Day and Kwik Cricket 'G-Ashes'
- There have been 13 inter school events
- **100% of the school have represented their house this year**
- **92% of children have represented the school this year**

# Extra Curricular Context

- Over the course of the week there are 8 sports clubs that continue to be on offer to the children
- 6 of the clubs are run by external providers
- 6 of the 8 clubs are fully inclusive open for children to access across the school, in all year groups, for all abilities and for both genders
- Due to the limited site, every opportunity is taken to maximise the space on offer through the week, even a before school judo club and lunchtime circuit training



# The Extra Curricular Numbers

- 176 children (73% of the school) participate in extra curricular sports clubs
- 107 (61%) are boys and 69 (39%) are girls
- 15 (45% of school) are children on the SEND register
- 10 (40% of school) are children who qualify for FSM



# 2024/25 Actions - 'Raising the Bar' at GJS

- Maintain provision of circuit training club and offer to upper school for Autumn and lower school for the spring
- Explore further opportunities for external provider provision
- Aim to increase the extra curricular participation levels by 10% (20+ children)
- Increase the participation rate of groups within the school e.g. girls and vulnerable groups by 5%
- Aim to maintain the high number of children representing their house
- Aim to increase the number of children representing the school by 10% (20+ children) and explore greater inter school events for lower school children
