

School Day Arrangements (3,05pm)

Now that clubs have started by external providers we would like to ensure the end of the Now that clubs have started by external providers we would like to ensure the end of the school day is as calm, orderly and safe as possible and that everyone is clear on their end of day arrangements. We have a system at GJS where by the children are lined up in 3 groups at the end of the day in their classes. Group 1 are those who attend clubs and are 'handed over' to meet the leads for these clubs in the school hall. A member of the school staff then brings the rest of the children (Group 2 and 3) outside. Group 2 are those who leave independently and Group 3 are those who wait with staff until a parent or carer picks them up. It is crucial that if the 'end of the day' arrangements change, for whatever reason, the school office are notified as soon as possible. We ask that contact is made no later than 1.30pm, via email, including your child's name and class. After this time, please call the school office with any last cluding your child's name and class. After this time, please call the school office with any last minute changes. This gives the office staff plenty of time to pass these changes onto class teachers.

<u>Dogs on Site</u>
Whilst we welcome 'furry' friends on site we do politely remind parents of our protocols as we start a new year. If you are bringing dogs to pick up your child we do insist that either they are small enough to be carried or you wait with them by The Pod near the Meadrow gate—away from the larger gathering of parents and children. If parents do not follow these protocols we may need to consider banning them altogether
