UNICEF RRS—Gold Award Presentation

Following a nervous wait after our assessment last term, GJS were finally awarded their Gold Mark, officially being recognised by UNICEF as a Gold standard Rights Respecting School and 1 of only 4 in all of Surrey to have achieved this accolade. We were honoured to have been presented our banner and certificate by Godalming Mayor, Penny Rivers. We are all extremely proud of the work we have done around the CRC and how the children are now able to articulate the importance of rights, their knowledge of the Articles and how this informs their behaviour in and around school. This all began in 2018 when the school achieved its bronze award. Following COVID in 2022 we achieved our silver and due to the wonderful work we were doing at GJS were encouraged to 'go for gold as soon as possible' by Helen Trivers at UNICEF. As another year draws to a close, we began to look toward to next year when classes met their new teachers this week and we welcomed our new Year 3s for the afternoon on Wednesday! It was great to see so many smiling faces be met by their teachers and meet their buddies whilst the rest of school 'stepped up' and began to feel that little bit more experienced as GJS members! Year 6 also spent the day at their secondary schools and have come back looking forward to the transition after spending the day facing their fears, meeting their new teachers and form groups. All staff will continue for the last few weeks to ensure transition is as seamless as possible, whether they are moving classes or moving schools.

Registration Time Change—September 2023
You may be aware that the DfE (Department for Education) recently released guidance regarding the length of the school week, found <u>here</u>. The expectation currently states that the minimum length of a school week is 32.5 hours from **registration** to the end of the day. Currently, the GJS day is 10minutes short of this expectation and we are planning on implementing a slope to the START of the school day from **September**. (the first day of term) we are proposing that the start of the day, and therefore registration, is taken from 8.35am. The school gates at Marshall Road and Hallam Road will continue to be opened from 8.25am each morning. We feel this part of the day would be easier to manage for parents and staff alike than extending the end of the day (thus having a greater impact on pick up arrangements at our local feeder schools by parents or carers). Whilst this has yet to be confirmed, we would welcome views on this from our stakeholders in the hope that we can applied a definitive response to these expectations in the coming weeks before the end of term give a definitive response to these expectations in the coming weeks before the end of term and for any parental arrangements to be covered by the start of the autumn term.
