Defibrillator

Thank you to everyone who has contributed so far. There is still time to help support the school in reaching its goal! As you may know, as many as 100,000 people are admitted to hospital each year due to heart attacks, that is one every 5 minutes. With it becoming more commonplace for public use defibrillators in towns or communal areas, we feel that as we have over 300 people attending school or living in the immediate vicinity, it is important to have a unit installed at the school to service the wider community in addition to being available within school. As there is a significant cost implication, we are asking parents for a voluntary financial contribution to assist the PTA donation and school budget in purchasing, installing and servicing the unit. 
