GJS Surveys

Thank you to all stakeholders who responded to the recent surveys that were sent out by the Governing Body at GJS. Children, parents and staff were all surveyed on a number of school matters ranging from behaviour, workload and communication to curriculum content, attendance and safety. ALL responses have been analysed during our recent Governor Day and subsequent committee meetings. We are now in the process of celebrating the areas of strengths within the school but most importantly setting about addressing the areas of improvement identified that will become school priorities for the coming year. These include reviewing the lines of communication between home and school and continuing to concentrate our efforts in ensuring progress and attainment in all areas is as high as it can be.

Year 5 Mubarak Mosque Visitors
On Thursday, Year 5 received a visit from the Imam and his wife from Mubarak Mosque in Tilford. We learnt about what the mosque was like, what happens at the mosque and how Muslims recognise and practice the 5 Pillars of Islam. The children were able to build on their knowledge from their RE unit on Islam and asked very thoughtful and respectful questions to help increase their understanding.

Registration Time Change—September 2023
You may be aware that the DfE (Department for Education) recently released guidance regardrou may be aware that the DTE (Department for Education) recently released guidance regarding the length of the school week, found here. The expectation currently states that the minimum length of a school week is 32.5 hours from registration to the end of the day. Currently, the GJS day is 10minutes short of this expectation and we are planning on implementing a slight change to the START of the school day from September. From Monday 4th September (the first day of term) we are proposing that the start of the day, and therefore registration, is taken from 8.35am. The school gates at Marshall Road and Hallam Road will continue to be proposed from 8.25am each marriage. We feel this part of the day would be easier to manage for opened from 8.25am each morning. We feel this part of the day would be easier to manage for parents and staff alike than extending the end of the day (thus having a greater impact on pick up arrangements at our local feeder schools by parents or carers). Whilst this has yet to be confirmed, we would welcome views on this from our stakeholders in the hope that we can give a definitive response to these expectations in the coming weeks before the end of term and for any parental arrangements to be covered by the start of the autumn term.
