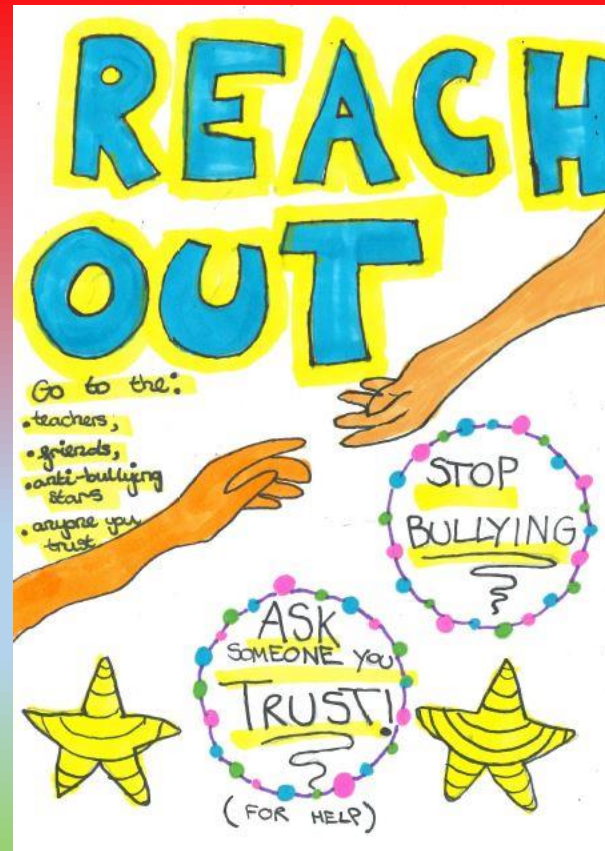

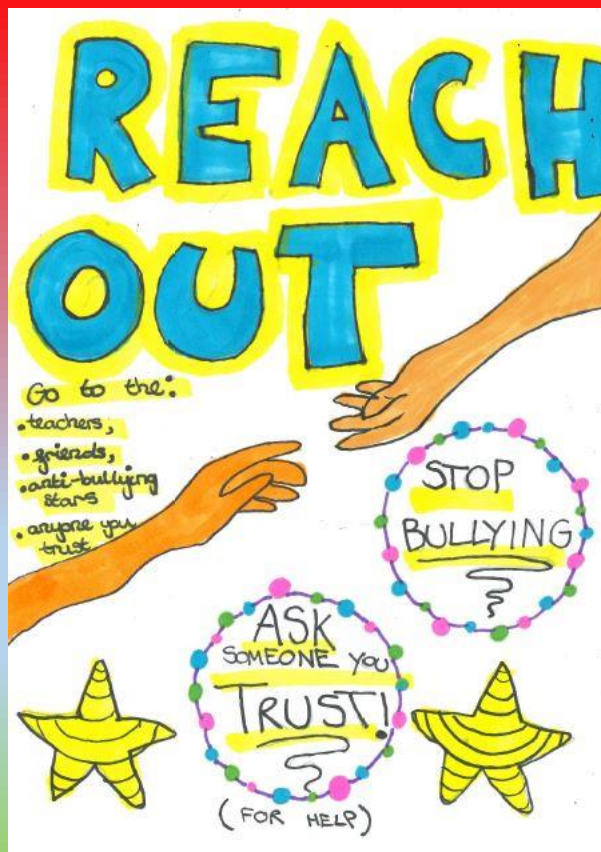

They will then be judged by our AB Stars and shared in a later Celebration Assembly



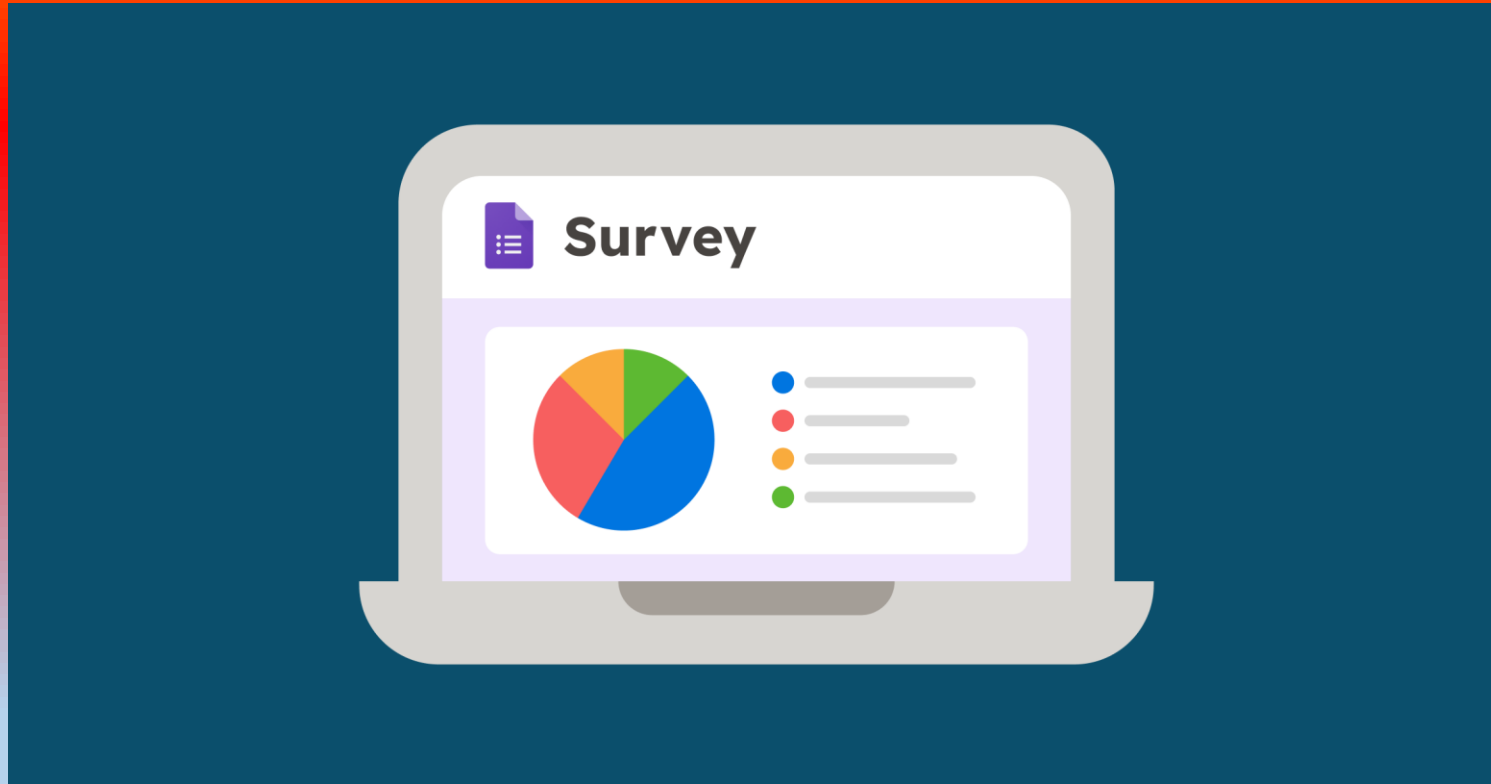
YOU will all take part in our annual anti bullying survey too
