○ Reading:

88% Achieved ARE* - National Average: **74%**

47% Exceeded ARE - National Average: **27%**** (NA for GDS unknown)

○ Writing:

80% Achieved ARE* - National Average: **72%**

28% Exceeded ARE - National Average: **20%**** (NA for GDS unknown)

○ SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar):

83% Achieved ARE - National Average: **72%**

47% Exceeded ARE - National Average: **36%**** (NA for GDS unknown)

Maths:

82% Achieved ARE - National Average: **73%**

30% Exceeded ARE - National Average: **27%**** (NA for GDS unknown)

Percentage of children at GJS who achieved ARE in all disciplines:

75% - National Average: **61%** (same as last year)

Contextual Information

➤ Numbers on Roll:

- There were 60 children on roll in year 6 and all children took part in the SAT's tests
- There were 31 boys and 19 girls in year 6
- 21 children (34%) were considered either SEND, qualified for Pupil Premium support or considered EAL (English not being their first spoken language)

➤ Attendance:

- Attendance for Year 6 up until July 2023 was 97%
- Pupil Premium Year 6 pupils attendance was 95%
